### **Professional experience**

#### **Commercial and Maritime Arbitrator (April 2014 – Date)**

Duncan received his first appointment as an Arbitrator when he was appointed in September 2008 by the ICC as an arbitrator in an international case. Duncan has subsequently been appointed as a party-appointed arbitrator in many LMAA arbitrations. He has also acted as Chairman, panel member and sole arbitrator in LCIA arbitrations and as arbitrator in an UNCITRAL arbitration administered by the LCIA.

#### **Lewis Silkin LLP, Solicitors, London (2008 – 2014)**

Duncan joined Lewis Silkin in 2008. He was a Partner in the Litigation and Dispute Resolution Department of Lewis Silkin until the end of March 2014.

Duncan arbitrated throughout his professional life. He was involved in over 200 significant commercial and shipping arbitrations as Counsel in the last 25 years. He has represented clients in complex domestic and international arbitrations under most of the major institutional rules (particularly ICC and LCIA) and in the shipping field (LMAA arbitrations). As well as commercial and shipping arbitrations, Duncan's work has included arbitrations in the IT, life sciences and telecoms fields.
